The **Steve Golodner Scholarship** was established in 2004 in memory of Steve Golodner. Steve was a very active Eagle Regiment parent, member of the field crew, and voluntarily took it upon himself to video tape and photograph the Eagle Regiment, as well as compiling the first year end video montage that we all treasure. Through his constant good nature, endless willingness to help wherever he was needed, and humble gratitude for the friendships he built over his many years as an Eagle Regiment parent, Steve truly embodied all that is so wonderful about the Eagle Regiment program. For Steve and his wife Kim, the Eagle Regiment became, as it has for so many of us, their “extended family.”

Steve treated each Eagle Regiment member as his own child, and served as mentor and advisor to countless Eagle Regiment students over the years. His daughter, Casey, was a guard member from 1998 to 2001 and his son, Jesse, was a band member from 2000 to 2004, also serving as band captain in his senior year. When Steve passed away suddenly on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2004, the Eagle Regiment lost a caring volunteer that many students considered as their “adopted Dad.”

A \$250 scholarship is awarded annually. **The scholarship is awarded to a graduating student at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School who embodies Steve Golodner’s spirit of giving, dedication and positive energy.** To apply, you must be an active member of the Eagle Regiment in good standing and must be graduating from Stoneman Douglas High School in the current school year. You must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and submit an essay explaining how your shared interest in a spirit of giving, dedication and positive energy has influenced your participation in the Eagle Regiment and how it will influence your life in the future.

The completed application form and essay must be submitted to later than **4:00 PM on Friday, May 1, 2020**. The scholarship recipient will be determined by the Marching Eagle Parent Association (MEPA) Board of Directors.

To be considered for this scholarship, you must submit the following documentation:

- Signed, completed application
- Essay explaining how your shared interest has influenced your participation in the Stoneman Douglas Eagle Regiment and how it will influence your life in the future.

All of the above items must be submitted to MEPA, Attention: Steve Golodner Scholarship by **Friday, May 1, 2020 at 4 PM**. The scholarship winner will be announced at the Stoneman Douglas Band Banquet.
