Officer Descriptions

Band Captain

The Band Captain is the highest leadership position in the Eagle Regiment and acts as a direct liaison between the Students and Directors. The Band Captain leads the band in all activities and therefore, must be comfortable speaking in front of large groups as well as demonstrate superior musicianship. The Band Captain is responsible for organizing and devising agendas for officer meetings. During officer workdays, the Band Captain will assist the Directors in devising duty rosters for students. The Band Captain is ultimately responsible for ALL aspects of the Eagle Regiment.

Drum Major

During marching band rehearsals and performances, the Drum Major is the Commander of the band. The Drum Major must have confidence, superior leadership and Communication skills, advanced conducting skills, and the ability to command respect from his or her peers. They must memorize their musical score as well as the drill count structures. In addition to this, he or she must be comfortable in commanding the band at football games/pep rallies. Drum Majors must demonstrate outstanding attendance and be willing to sacrifice much personal time for the band; attending every rehearsal and performance. The Drum Majors are also responsible for setting up the Metronome for all rehearsals.

Office Manager

The Office Manager is responsible for all logistics involving the Eagle Regiment. The Office Manager is responsible for attendance at every practice and performance. In addition to this, the Office Manager helps the Directors maintain records and binders in the band office. At officer meetings, the Office Manager records the minutes of the meeting for submission to the Director of Bands and Activities Director. The Office Manager is the direct link between the Director and the Leadership Staff.

Captain of Brass, Woodwind, Percussion

Each Section plays a vital role in the success of the band program. Captains should demonstrate a superior level of proficiency on their instrument as well as command the respect of their peers. They are responsible for ensuring that their sections know their music, drill, and other required elements within the band program. They have to assist the Secretary with attendance at each rehearsal and performance, and enforce expectations as stated in the band handbook. Captains will also be in charge of Locker and Instrument assignments.

Lieutenant of Brass, Woodwind, Percussion

The duties and expectations for Lieutenant are very similar to those of the Brass/WW/Perc Captain. In addition, the Lieutenants are responsible for all of the rooms in the Music Wing.

Equipment Crew Manager

The Equipment Crew Manager is responsible for the equipment used by the Eagle Regiment. They are responsible for the safe onload and offload of equipment before, during, and after rehearsal/performance. It is also the ECM's responsibility to alert the Band Directors of any equipment that may be missing, broken, or damaged. This position also requires that the ECM arrive before events and stay at the conclusion, when needed. In addition, they are responsible for selecting a crew that will assist with all on/off load, set up of Eagle Regiment equipment.

Meteorologist

The Meteorologist is responsible for sharing the rehearsal/performance weather forecast with the Eagle Regiment. The Meteorologist is also responsible for sharing best practices regarding hydration and wellness.

Librarian

The Librarians are responsible for filing music, scanning music, and passing out and collecting music. Upkeep and maintenance of the music library is essential. Librarians must realize that this is a yearlong endeavor, and not something that ends after marching band season.
